



Board Responsibilities

- **Commitment**
 - Board members serve two year terms. Board officers are elected annually.
 - Attend 11 board meetings and 1 strategic retreat per year and show up prepared to meetings by having read the Board packet
 - Commitment time: Approximately 3 hours per month (average, see below regarding BMA Committee involvement)
- **Virtual Board Meetings (aka email and Slack)**
 - Read your email and respond as appropriate within two business days
 - Use the Slack app and respond to direct messages and @here and @channel in #board within two business days
- **Participate in a BMA Committee**
 - Every Board Member is expected to participate in one committee at minimum
 - If you are a Committee chair, keep the Board updated quarterly on committee activity; Committee reports are typically included in the Board packet circulated before each meeting
- **Participate in BMA Activities**
 - Attend two volunteer events per year
 - Attend major BMA events as requested by Board President
- **Community Behavior / Fiduciary Duties**
 - Always disclose potential conflicts of interest to the Board
 - Follow BMA's Communication policy
 - Do not use BMA board service for your personal financial gain (apart from networking and getting to enjoy awesome trails and endless gratitude)
- **Financial Commitment**
 - Each board member is responsible to make a personally meaningful annual gift and participate in "friendraising" by bringing at least two new guests to a BMA activity.
